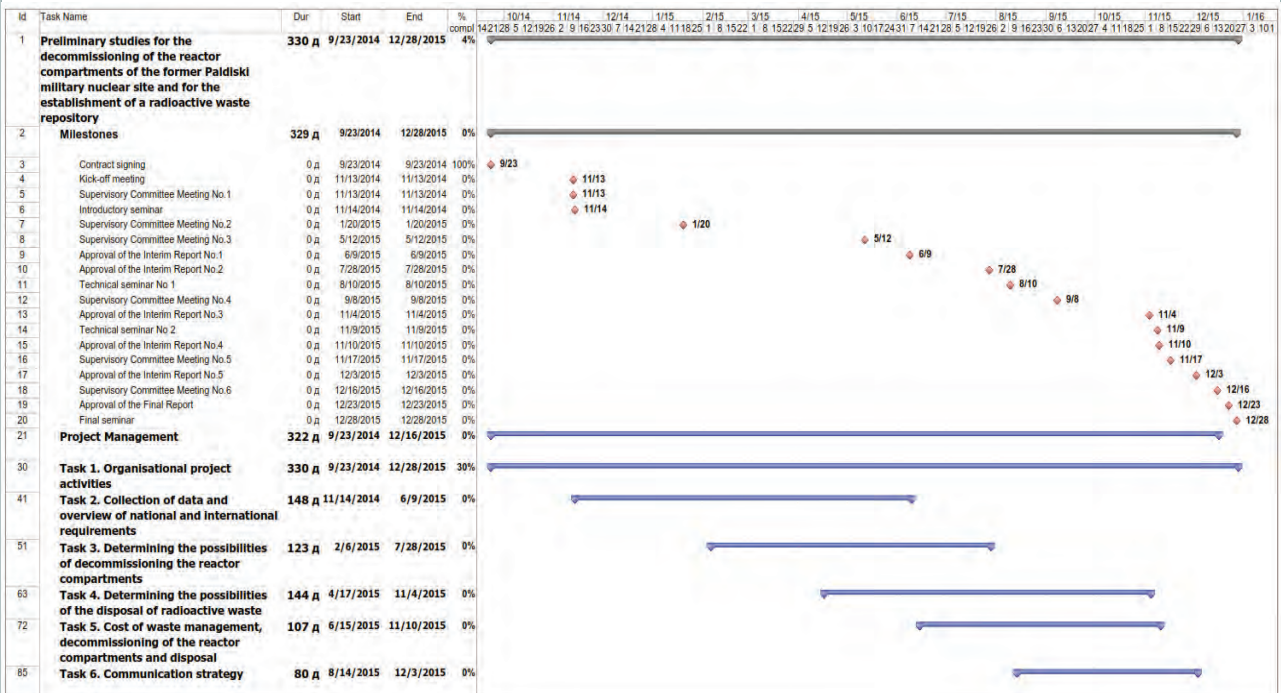
PRELIMINARY DESCRIPTION OF THE FEASIBILITY STUDIES
