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Legislative framework

- ESPOO Convention on EIA in transboundary context
- EU Directive 2014/52/EU of 16 April 2014 amending Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment
- EU Directive 2011/70/Euratom establishing a Community framework for the responsible and safe management of spent fuel and radioactive waste
- National legal acts



Nuclear Waste Directive

In July 2011 EU Council adopted Directive 2011/70/Euratom:

- It requires to inform the public during all stages of waste management
- Public information issues have to be reflected in the National Waste Management Plan

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Public information planning

- Special attention should be paid to disposal planning and site selection stages
 - Success of the program depends on public opinion
 - Public attitudes is one of key criterion for siting of disposal facility

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The main goals

- To facilitate implementation of waste management project by increasing public support
- To know the public opinion
 - to use as one of site selection criterion

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Implementation plan

- Special attention will delivered to planning of short term activities

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Inputs required

- Information on social, economic and political situation
- the existing information channels
- data from public opinion surveys
